At New England Financial (NEF), Jack served as Senior Vice President for Product Marketing. Reporting to the CEO, he was responsible for the strategic direction of NEF's eight major product lines from product inception through launch and ongoing profit performance. Prior to its merger with MetLife, New England Financial was the oldest mutual life insurer in the United States.

Jack most recently served as Managing Director - Principal Gifts and Strategic Initiatives at Bentley University. In this role, Jack worked collaboratively with the University's President and key executive management team members regarding the development and execution of leading funding strategies for Bentley's top twenty-five donors. Additionally, in 2005, Jack co-founded the Bentley Executive Club, an organization comprised of over two hundred and twenty-five senior level Bentley University alumni and supporters.

Jack's governance expertise emanates from his service on numerous for profit and nonprofit Boards of Directors. These organizations include the Windsor Marketing Group of Connecticut, Wentworth Institute of Technology and the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, where he served as Board chair, both of Massachusetts.
